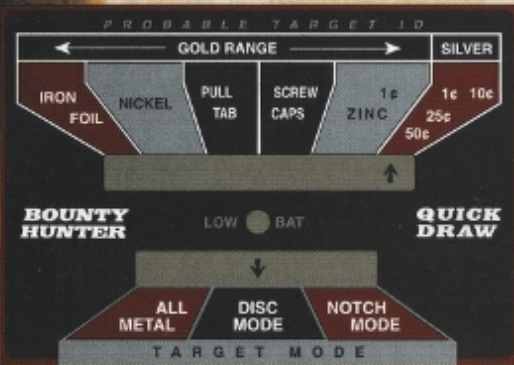

PRESS TO SELECT TARGET MODE

ALL METAL | DISC | NOTCH

This is a Motion Detector System and movement is required to make detection. Searchcoil must move across target (or target move across searchcoil). DISC (Discriminate) will eliminate iron and reject trash as control is turned towards high. NOTCH will eliminate iron, retain nickels and reject mid-range trash as control is turned towards high.

EASY TO OPERATE!

Press ALL METAL pad and all metals are detected with a medium tone. Press DISC to reject Iron and detect desired targets with Three Tone Audio—Low tone for small gold and nickels medium tone for tabs, caps, and zinc pennies. High tones for other coins and silver. Press notch to reject iron and tabs, yet detect nickels and other good targets.

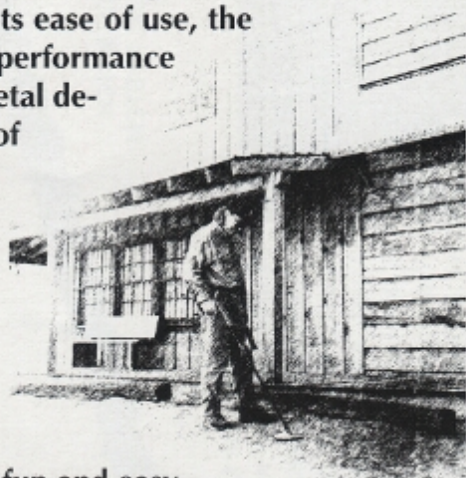

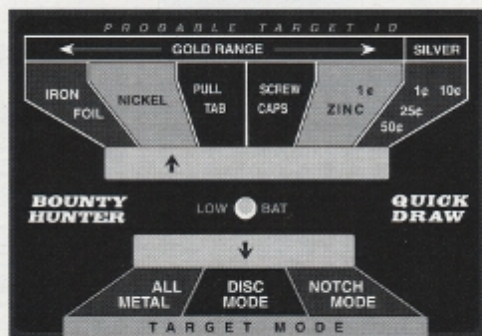
When operating in the DISC MODE, detected targets will have three distinct tone categories for helpful identification of the detected item.

With some practice, it is easy to be able to determine most of the time what type of metal is being detected just by the tones being emitted by the Quick Draw.

The Target ID will "lock" onto a target and hold a reading until another target is detected. The Target Mode indicator will have one arrow pointing to the mode of operation being used. Until another mode of operation is chosen, the arrow remains allowing a constant visual reference of what mode of operation is being used.

The Low Battery indicator will come on and stay on when batteries are low.

LCD READOUT



AVAILABLE COIL SYSTEMS: Bounty Hunter Accessories include two other very practical coil systems that can be interfaced with the Quick Draw: the 4-Inch Gold Nugget Coil—excellent for prospecting and coin shooting in trash-laden areas, and the 10-Inch Magnum Coil—used mostly for relic hunting and for deeper probing.

S-ROD HANDLE SYSTEM: The S-Rod Handle System that comes with the unit, includes a stand to prevent the unit from falling over when placed on the ground horizontally. This allows for hands-free digging while eliminating dirt from getting onto the control panel.

ALL METAL OPERATION:

In the All Metal mode, the Quick Draw will respond to all types of metal without any discrimination. The audio output emits only one tone instead of the three emitted in Disc and Notch modes. The search coil will still require movement to detect a target as it does in the DISC mode. The unit requires no adjustment for ground balancing making the Quick Draw quick and easy to operate.

DISC MODE:

In this mode of operation, the detector will automatically reject iron and can then be adjusted by the DISC/NOTCH control for increased discrimination selective to the user's particular needs.

NOTCH:

In the NOTCH position most pull tabs, iron and light foil will automatically be rejected; thus, the detector will generally respond to COINS. As the DISC/NOTCH control is turned higher, the Notch widens, allowing screw caps and then zinc pennies to be notched out.

DISC/NOTCH VARIABLE CONTROL:

This variable control allows selective response to targets that are in the tab/screw cap range. When the mode touchpad is set to DISC, the control functions as a standard variable discriminator. As the control is increased from its low position—foil, nickels, pull tabs, screw caps, and zinc pennies will be rejected in stated order. When the mode touchpad is set to NOTCH, the DISC/NOTCH variable control will work as a width control allowing for fine tuning and selective elimination of zinc pennies and screw caps.
