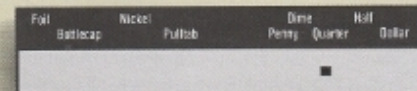

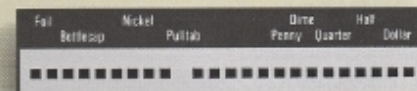

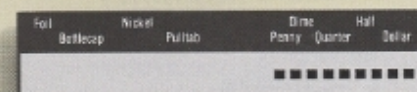

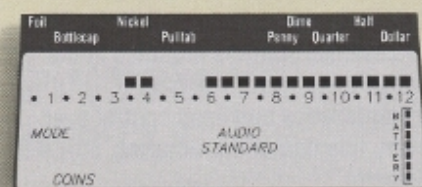

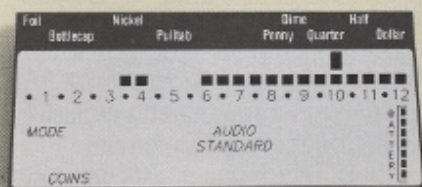

Still three months short of his 34th birthday, he could already reflect on a career in metal detecting that might stir envy in even the most considerate old-timer.

With coin recoveries numbering over 300,000, detection of more than 5,000 projectiles, plus countless thousands of other items—and, in a job that literally enables him to hunt all over the world—Andy Sabisch has indeed been active over 25 (yes, he started when he was a lad of 9) years.

This pleasant native of upstate New York offers gratifying evidence that "good will come for people who do the right thing." Andy has continued to do the right



thing in life and as a metal detectorist. With a degree in nuclear engineering and U.S. Navy training, he stands at the forefront of this 21st-century career. As a detectorist, he works solidly and by the book... quality instrument, methodical research, proper record-keeping and good technique—all combined with real concern for the environment and for others.

He's hunted with literally scores of different detectors but suggests simply that a THER always use a high quality detector and that he (or she) understand all about that detector and its capabilities.

Despite his personal success, Andy urges newcomers to the hobby not to expect instant financial rewards. "Just consider metal detecting as a hobby that can pay for itself," he advises, "and enjoy yourself whenever you're out hunting." 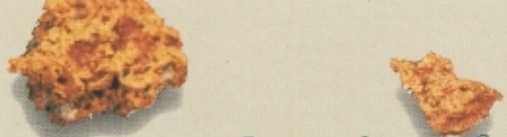

Roy Lagal Lewiston, ID

His biography describes a *Thing* legend: boyhood on the Kansas-Oklahoma border amid tales of settler's caches and the hidden wealth of Osage and Cherokee Indians...Army service with mine detectors during World War II...a quarter-century of pursuing great treasures of the American West.

Roy smiles as he reminisces about the time he and his bride Gerri set out for full-time treasure hunting some 45 years ago. "We aimed for a big 'un," he recalls. "the Lost Dutchman mine in Arizona, and we went broke before we found it."

This genial and modest man wouldn't mind if you believed "going broke before we found it" the story of his life, but long-time *THers* assure you otherwise. Roy Lagal found more than a few of the "big 'uns" he sought.

For nearly 30 years he and Gerri traveled over the West—and, even to Florida—as they prospected and dredged



for gold and hunted for caches and other treasures. They often lived in the ghost towns they explored, and home was where their hats were. These decades of rambling were punctuated by achievements such as

patenting the famed "Gravity Trap" gold pan, writing classic texts on electronic prospecting and metal detection and helping develop, along with Charles Garrett, the first metal detectors designed primarily to hunt for gold. Too, after settling in Nez Perce Indian country, Roy became recognized as one of the world's experts in their lore and the recovery of Indian caches.

How he loves to talk of caches...those that might have been found and all those he's still researching and seeking! Yet Roy offers an unusual tip for all treasure hunters: don't get carried away with research. "Of course, some research is absolutely necessary, and a lot may be important," he explains. "But if you have a chance to recover a treasure, take it! Don't wait for a lot of research."

Still, like other great hunters, he's silent about his own recoveries. "I've found a few," he'll grudgingly admit, "but probably no more than one a year when it's all figured out." Yet, that "one a year" plus his work with gold pans, metal detectors and writing "figgers out" Roy to be a contented and successful man indeed.

Ask Barbara and Jack Phillips if they've found anything special while metal detecting. They might mention a husband and a wife, respectively, for starters. Then again, Jack might tell you of his 1814 Spanish gold piece, and Barbara might rave about her wonderful new life style that revolves around metal detecting. Or, they might cite one of the 100,000 or more coins and other items they've found.

The facts are, however, that both Barbara and Jack were already detector enthusiasts when they met a few years ago...at a hunt, naturally...and they remain enthusiastic as husband and wife. Just a Hobbyist...

Ed Morris

Santa Maria, CA

Six months after he joined the Army in mid-summer 1941 Ed Morris was startled to find a war on his hands. Thirty years later, after both uniformed and civilian service with the Air Force, he found himself retired with time on his hands.

As a public affairs officer and sometime newspaperman Ed had developed skills that led to a successful post-retirement career in writing. Metal detectors were a featured topic, and Charles Garrett became a favorite interview subject. Ed is no longer a writer, but he now has a hobby to take care of his spare time.

Ed began writing about—and hunting with—Garrett detectors two decades ago and participated actively in the growth of metal detecting for a number of years. His byline was a familiar one in numerous pub-

lications as Ed became somewhat of a professional THer himself and remained on the cutting edge of the industry. "Those early detectors may have been primitive," Ed recalls, "but I sure had fun using them...and always made good recoveries."

He remembers lonely beaches and empty schoolyards in Southern California



where his Garrett was the only metal detector in sight. "Sure, there are more hobbyists out there today," he concedes, "but the detectors are so much better! And, there's still plenty of treasure." Ed observes that instruments such as today's GTA 1000 enable him to isolate and recover targets he could never have found before.

"The good hunting grounds always seem to regenerate themselves," he observes. "Plus, today's detectors continue to create new opportunities for hobbyists."

One bit of advice Ed offers newcomers is to "mind your manners." He urges all who use metal detectors to be kind to the areas where they hunt, particularly in making recoveries. Ed notes that he sometimes will leave a penny (as shown on his GTA meter) in the ground if the recovery seems too difficult.

"We should all work together to protect the hobby of metal detecting," Ed proclaims. "It's a great hobby, and, I'm certainly glad to be part of it!"

A Half Century in the Field...

Nigel & Derek Ingram

Birmingham, England

From somewhat austere beginnings in 1972 to the pole position on the British retailing grid it now enjoys, Regton Ltd, Garrett's distributor in England, can boast of an unassailable reputation for excellence that was steadily built up by Derek Ingram, a former RAF pilot. With Derek's son Nigel, a geology graduate and treasure hunter since age 9, now part of the firm, they boast almost 50 years of treasure hunting experience.

Their showroom at 82 Cliveland Street is a meeting place for many of Britain's top-flight THers, where over a mug of tea or coffee, treasure tales, news and views and the latest developments are pondered...all silently witnessed by display cases crammed with finds.



Derek recalls his most satisfying recovery as a cache of money and jewelry valued at £13,000 sterling that was located for dependents of a deceased relative. Nigel's favorite find was made for a Belgian marquis who had irretrievably lost a two-and-one-half-ounce gold ring.

As a long-time detectorist, Derek has made other contributions to the hobby. He patented the "S-style" detector stem, now used by Garrett for its GTA and Freedom lines and by numerous other manufacturers. For this simple but effectual advance in metal detector design Derek Ingram was made a life member of the International Treasure Hunting Society.

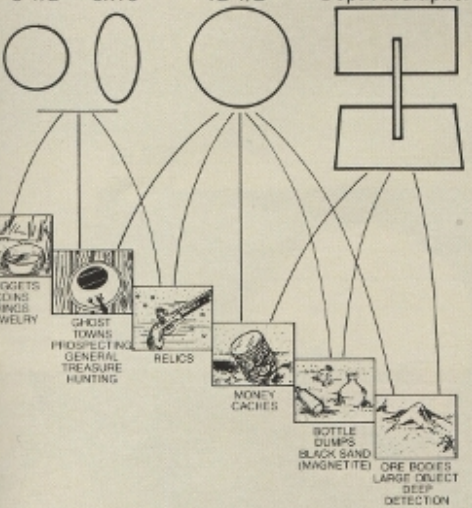
Among detectors available today Derek favors the GTA 1000, calling it "the simplest, most effective ground coverer

there is...and it's light and weatherproof." He emphasizes the importance of pinpointing with his slogan of "search low and pinpoint high." Derek challenges any THer to try this simple test: place a coin under a sheet of newspaper and pinpoint the coin. When located, pierce the sheet with a pencil to check accuracy. Three hits in a row means you're not doing badly!

When not diving with the XL500 Sea Hunter, Derek hunts on land with CX detectors which he prefers "because of their versatility and because they can accept the Depth Multiplier."

With the popularity of motion detectors Nigel offers advice for using these machines immediately adjacent to water. "Never search by walking parallel to the water; always walk towards, or away from, it." Why? Ground effects on circuitry, he explains. When searching parallel to water, the sweep closest to the water will become "disturbed" and, thus, not so sensitive to valuable targets.

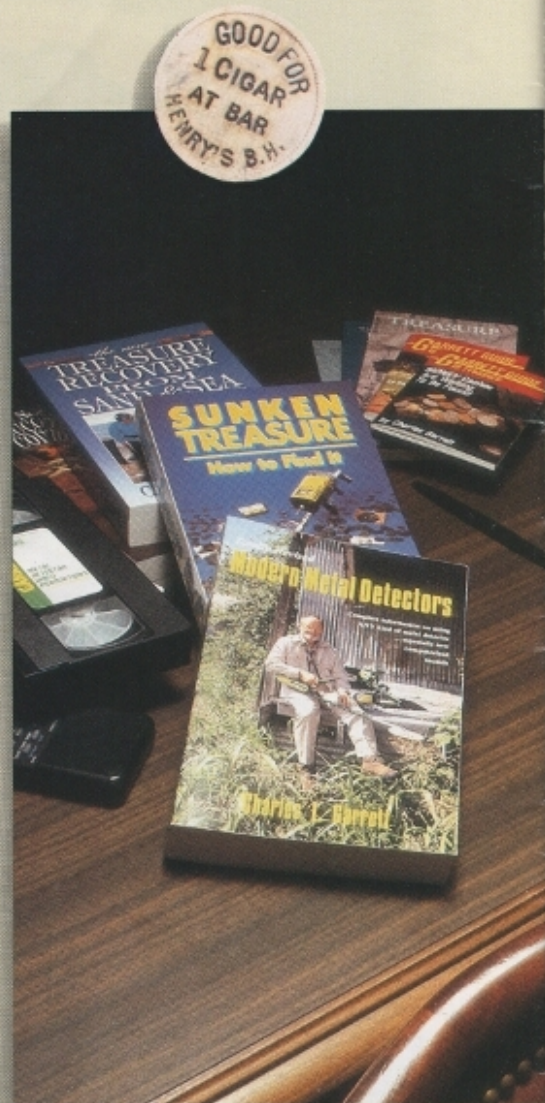
