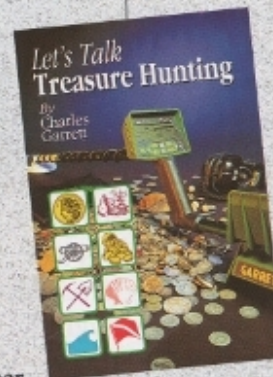

The appeal of treasure hunting is universal. It transcends all boundaries of age, sex, personality and social status. The desire to seek and find hidden wealth is as old as mankind.

Treasure hunting is difficult to define because it can mean so many different things. Basically, it is the search for and recovery of anything that you consider valuable. That's right, only you can determine what's treasure and what's not. Coins, costume jewelry, money caches and relics are all treasure just the same as gold and jewels or whatever else you are looking for.

No matter what the target, THing is an absolutely universal outdoor hobby! Anyone can hunt treasure with equal intensity anywhere on the face of the earth or under its waters. Each individual decides how much energy is required for participation in the hobby, and the decision can be changed from day to day or even from one minute to the next. The hobbyist can hunt for hours a day or for just a short while; the hunting may be strenuous or involve little exertion.

Treasure hunting sites are equally optional. While hidden wealth can be sought at exotic foreign locations, many successful THers swear that the ideal hunting ground is one's own back yard or neighborhood.

Some people want (or, expect) to strike it rich the very first time they turn on a detector, while others are content to find little more than a few coins in the local park. Some individuals hunt with a detector for the excitement of digging a treasure out of the ground, while others are fascinated by the "historical" discoveries they make. 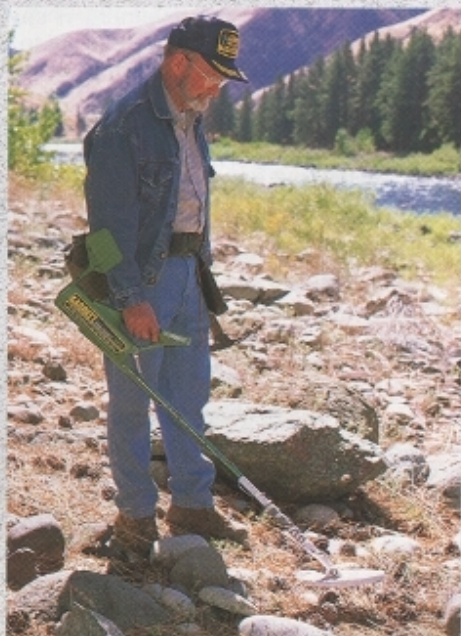

Relic Hunting

Early-day settlers simply picked up relics while plowing or discovered them in old battlefields. Those days are long past. Those remaining are below the earth's surface — sometimes far below — and can be located only by the modern ground-balanced metal detector.

"Battlefield relics" abound throughout our country. The term "relics" includes far more than implements of war and destruction. In fact, the dictionary definition is "a trace of the past." Collectors specialize in relics from almost every sector of society and life.

We recommend that relic hunters operate in the non-motion All Metal mode for greatest depth. Precise ground balancing circuitry on modern detectors, such as Fast Track on all of Garrett's CX detectors solves mineralization problems. If you're really not concerned about losing just an occasional target, operate in the Discriminate mode — but, with only a slight amount of discrimination. You'll miss small iron objects (including trash), but will detect lead, brass, bronze and coins.



Because any battlefield might contain explosives, take all necessary precautions. Any time you dig an object you suspect might be an explosive, consult an authority... quickly! Research is particularly important to relic hunters, yet often times, all the research in the world cannot tell you if battle action occurred or gunfire took place at that precise spot. Only your detector can prove this by locating cartridges, bullets or other projectiles.

Many of the "obvious" locations to search for relics are now located in various state and national monuments and parks where the use of metal detectors is either banned entirely or highly restricted. Never violate these regulations. You'll find relics aplenty by seeking out locations about which only you and few others know...perhaps you can develop these by learning more about the history of your own ancestors.

Cache Hunting

Caches come in all sizes, and they're generally dreamed of as a Wells Fargo money box, an iron pot or a set of saddle bags...all stuffed with gold coins, old bills, and antique jewelry. Most caches are much smaller.

Regardless of the size cache you seek, you must be diligent. These factors will govern your application of basic treasure hunting techniques:

- Geographic location of the treasure site;
- Ground condition of the site and vegetation covering it;
- Mineral content of the soil;
- Physical size of the cache (generally overestimated!);
- Depth of the cache;
- Changes that might have occurred at the site since the cache was buried;
- Your detector and its searchcoil.

Misjudgment of any one of the above can keep you from recovering the prize you seek.

If you seek real cache hunting success, you must be prepared to dig lots of junk! Does your detector have a true non-motion All Metal mode? It better! The principal reason for using this mode can be spelled out in one

word...depth. There's just no question that non-motion All Metal circuitry will probe deeper than any Discriminate mode. Always use the largest coil possible. Remember that larger searchcoils can detect larger objects and detect them at greater depths. Money caches have been found at all depths (buried at arm's length seems to be popular), but be prepared for extremes.

All the more reason to use the larger coils — even the Depth Multiplier! An important feature of the Depth Multiplier is that it will not detect small objects.

Following are the primary rules that have proven successful for most of us cache hunters:

- Use a cache hunting detector and the largest coil available.
- Conduct extensive research; you can never know too much about your target and the individual(s) who hid it.
- Be patient throughout your effort, from planning to scanning to recovering.
- Never assume that because your target may be big that it will be easy to find.

If you haven't experienced the thrill of cache hunting, you can't know what you've missed. It's the thrill that should come to everyone at least once in a lifetime!

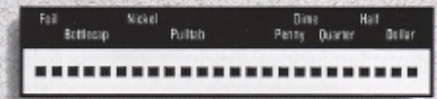

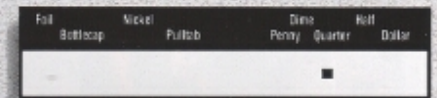

Coin Hunting

Hunting for coins is the heart and soul of the treasure hunting hobby...literally everybody hunts for coins. They are the initial target for most first-time detector owners.

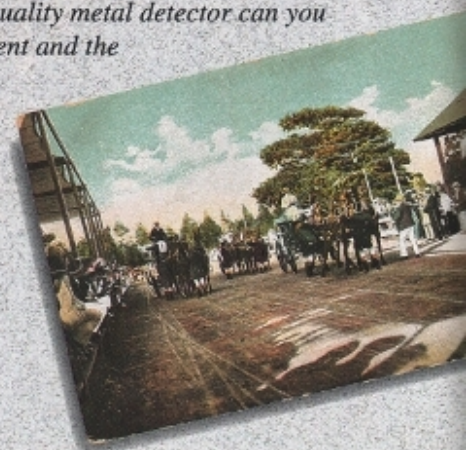
The number of lost coins far exceeds the total in circulation today. Multitudes of coins can be found everywhere; you just have to look for them. Charles Garrett knows that every metal detector he designs and builds will be used at one time or another to search for coins. In fact, many of the detectors will probably be used for no other purpose. Thus, it is essential that any detector hobbyist master coin-hunting techniques which will also be used in all other forms of THing.

The recommended detector for hunting coins is a modern instrument with automatic ground balancing and good discrimination. The best instruments, however, are the new computerized detectors with microprocessor controls that provide alternatives between several modes and discrimination levels.

Although they have universal capabilities, Ultra GTA detectors were designed primarily as coin hunters. The greater depth and precise discrimination possible with microprocessor controlled circuitry combine with the GTA's light weight and ease of handling to make it a superb instrument for finding coins.

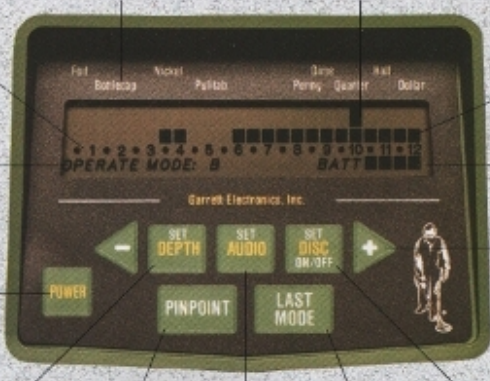

Looking for caches, seeking coins, hunting for relics... all of these can be pursued enjoyably in a ghost town, as well as the search of buildings, cabins and other structures that were once occupied.

The world's oceans, lakes and streams offer vast store-houses of lost wealth that await the treasure hunter. Beaches at the entrance to Davy Jones' locker present the most accessible areas for hobbyists to begin searching.

Charles Garrett advises every THER to become a beachcomber. The joys are countless, and the rewards are constantly surprising! Wherever people congregate (or, have congregated), treasure can be found. Out of sight below the sand lies that blanket of treasure awaiting the metal detector.

Oftentimes, the greatest joy for the beachcomber comes simply from walking the beach, from experiencing soft winds off the water and feeling the sand under bare feet while listening to the tranquilizing sounds of surf and sea breeze. The rewards of treasure hunting are but an added bonus.

Nobody should go pell-mell onto a beach and begin hunting here and there without a plan. The dedicated

THER always first answers the question of "Where?" with research. Beyond that, experience must be the teacher. Experience alone will educate the beach hunter about places that never produce and other places that are often rewarding. A knowledge of storm, wind and wave action will often rescue someone studying a new beach.

One of the great thrills of beach hunting is that "big one" that awaits your chance to strike it rich. Always be on the alert for treasure stories and legends. Don't waste good money on a "treasure map," but don't ignore those tales of missing treasures...of great losses and "almost" or partial recoveries. Not only will this add excitement to your hobby, but the stories sometimes prove to be true!

Finally, remember that a modern metal detector is a wonderful scientific instrument. It searches beneath the sand, where you cannot see. It is always vigilant about the presence of metal. But, no detector can "do it all." You must develop powers of observation that keep you attentive to what a detector cannot see.

Watch for the unusual! Sometimes you'll visually locate money, marketable sea shells or other valuables. 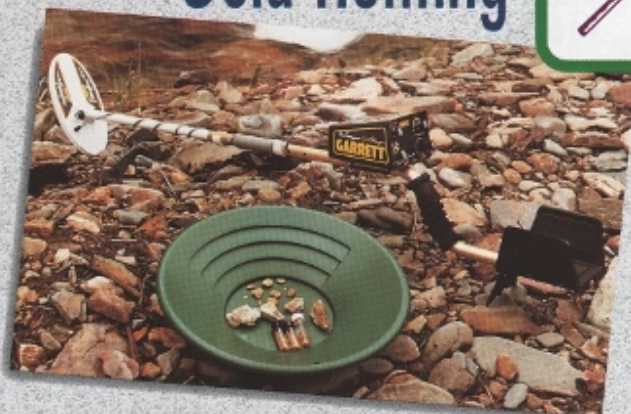

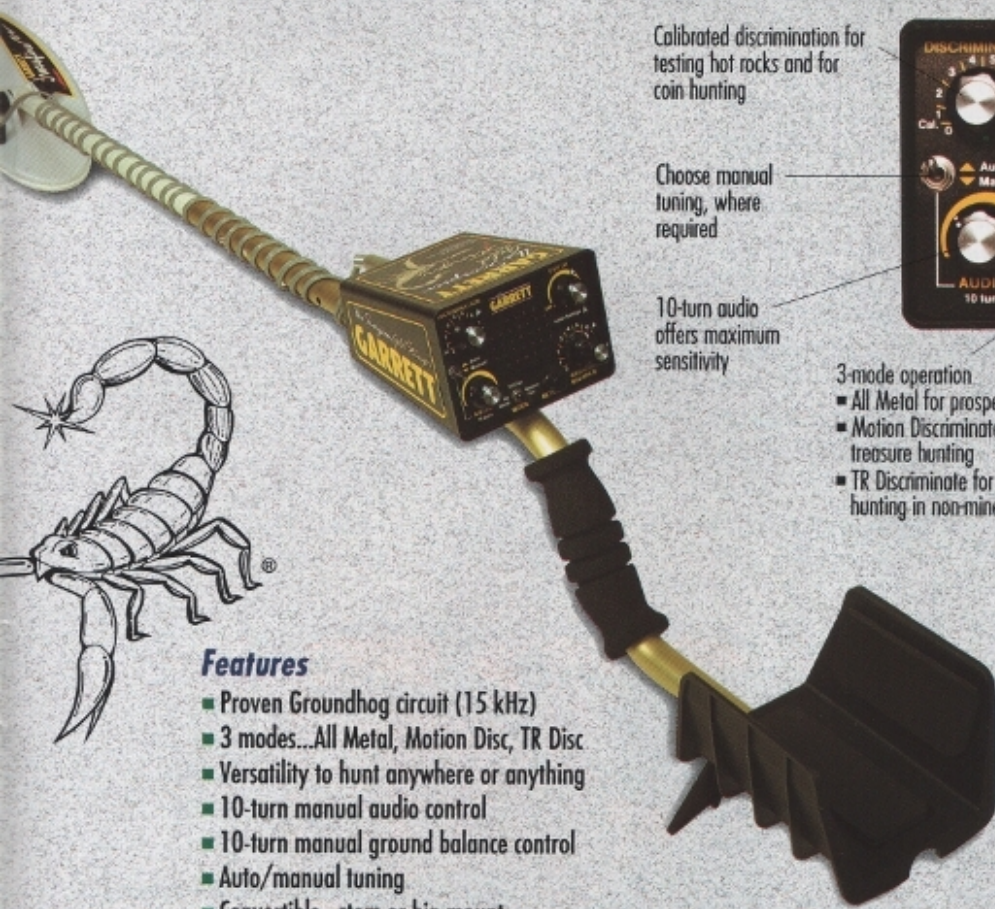
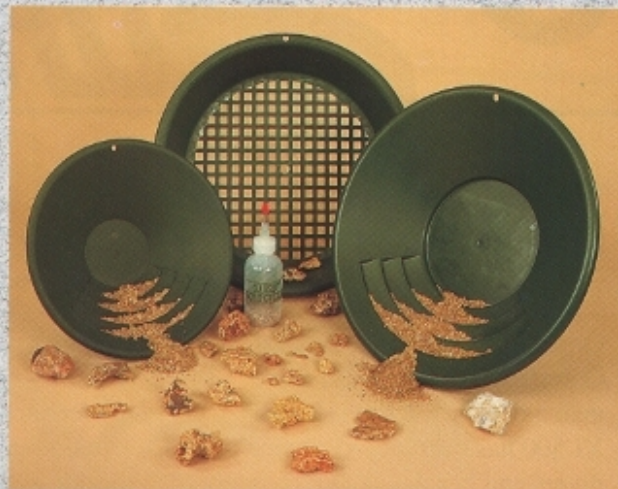

Speed Competition Hunting



Speed is vitally important in competition hunting. Winners exhibit speed of thought as well as speed of foot and hand. Learn the rules of the hunt and consider what your targets will be. If there are different types, seek those that win hunt prizes.

You'll normally compete in an All Metal mode. In addition, targets will probably be shallow. Before hunting, try to gain access to tokens or other items you will be seeking and set your detector's discrimination to detect only those prizes. If you hunt with a Garrett GTA, you can "notch" your detector for just these valuable items.

If you cannot get a look at targets before the hunt, be prepared to set your discrimination as soon as you find one. Because speed and accuracy are so essential, know your detector and its capabilities.

During the hunt itself, move quickly and recover as many targets as possible. One or two passes over a target and recover it. One method is to use a small pick...whack, and the target's uncovered. Stuff it in your pouch, cover the hole and move on. On a beach, use a scoop/sifter and sift as you walk to the next target. Remember, always check for multiple targets after you've made your recovery.

One final word: always cover your holes. It only takes a second to kick back the dirt or sand you removed, and there's never an excuse for rudeness. Good hunting!
