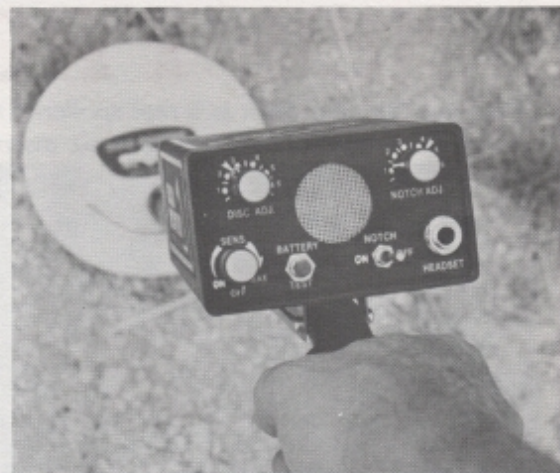

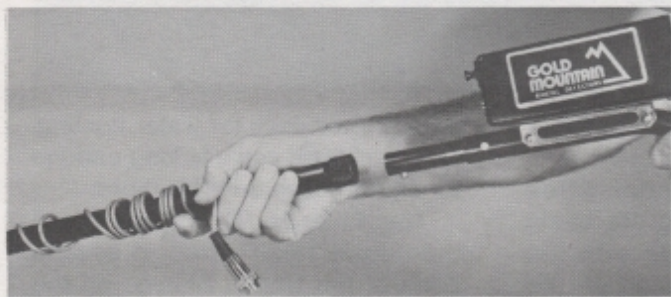

This new Thunder Stick is a real spoller! It's preset operation is simple. The Auto Ground Balance feature eliminates interference from mineralized ground, discrimination is excellent, and the depth is great!

The development of the Thunder Stick took several months. We wanted a new detector that would be simple to operate, light weight, and have excellent depth and notch discrimination. The Thunder Stick fits all of these qualifications.

With its silent, automatic operation there is no tuning, no threshold, no chance of drift, and no loss of sensitivity. The **Auto Ground Balance** circuit filters out interference from mineralized soil and salt water. The **Discrimination** circuit filters out small trash that causes other detectors to chatter and create false signals. The **Notch Discrimination** circuit allows you to reject bottlecaps, most pull-tabs, and screw caps while still being able to detect large and small rings, jewelry, coins (gold, silver and clad) and even nickels! This means that you can find more

items of value with less effort in a shorter period of time.

We made the Thunder Stick lightweight and strong. Its basic design is the 'S' handle with the control housing positioned on the top to prevent it from hitting you on your leg all the time. The padded armrest and only 3½ pounds of total weight enables you to hunt longer, which means more finds with less fatigue.

The handle and searchcoil shaft are easily separated into two sections—neither of which is longer than 22 inches. They will easily fit into a suitcase, small compartment or backpack. The control box is quickly removed by depressing buttons. Belt loops big enough to accept an army canteen belt are built into the box mounting bracket. The control box can be fitted to a strap (not included) and hung

around your neck for water hunting. The searchcoil cable is long enough for any of these configurations.

The Thunder Stick has been thoroughly field tested in several parts of the United States—on the east coast (both on the land and on the beach), in Colorado, Iowa, Minnesota, Texas, South Texas beaches, and even Cozumel, Mexico. Without exception the Thunder Stick performed well. It was able to handle all sorts of mineralization. Many coins and other valuables were found in places that had been hunted heavily with other more expensive top of the line metal detectors.

The Thunder Stick is made of quality components. With proper care it should last a lifetime. The warranty covers parts, labor and return shipping for two years after purchase. Its price is only \$429.00.
