Nothing puzzles, pesters and plagues the metal detectorist like the pull tab. If you turn up your discrimination high enough to knock them out, you lose nickels and gold rings. Keep the rings and you'll wind up digging a thousand pull tabs before you find your first gold ring.

The **Golden μ Max** uses three different systems to help you discriminate out unwanted pull tabs and other trash items. First, we started with Tesoro's ED 120 discrimination letting you decide how much junk to knock out. Detectorists around the world know our discrimination has been time tested and proven.

Second, a multi-tone ID gives you information to help you decide what targets to dig. The Golden μ Max has four target tones with a separate tone for saturation. The first tone is for iron. The second tone is for foil to just around nickels. The third covers most pull tabs

to around screw caps and the final tone is for pennies and silver. These are single tones and are easy to distinguish. Iron may also produce a rolling tone. It will either start high and go lower in pitch or start low and go higher, depending on the size and shape of the target. The saturation tone is a quick double beep that lets the user know that there is a shallow target. When you hear the double beep, just lift the coil an inch or two off the ground to get an accurate tone ID.

Third, we added a user adjustable Notch Filter Discrimination. Unlike other machines, the Golden μ Max gives you control of what falls inside the notch window. The first control is the Notch switch. It lets you choose between losing just pull tabs or pull tabs and screw caps. When the switch is set to the desired setting, the Notch Width knob allows adjustment of nickels, pull tabs and gold rings. All of these targets are very close together and in some areas even overlap. We give you the choice to find what you want. Don't want any pull tabs? You can knock them all out. Willing to get some pull tabs to keep rings and nickels? You can do that too. With the Golden μ Max, the choice is all in your hands.

The Tiger Shark uses microprocessor technology to create a true dual function machine. In Normal Mode, the Tiger Shark works like any other Tesoro detector. It uses the same great ground balance and discrimination features that made the Bandido series so successful. On land, the Tiger Shark can be used for coin and relic hunting and even gold prospecting. By using the four controls on the outside, you can fine tune your detector to handle whatever conditions you are working in.

Working in the wet salt areas is where the Tiger Shark outshines the land detectors. In land conditions, the most crucial adjustment is using the ground balance to tune out mineralization. In wet salt conditions, changes in the conductivity in the sand cause most of the problems. The Tiger Shark uses a completely different set of internal settings in the SALT Mode than in the NORM Mode. There are no special controls or techniques to remember.

The Tiger Shark continues in the tradition of other great Tesoro underwater machines by having interchangeable coils available. Along with the 8" coil that comes standard with the detector, we also manufacture a 7" and a 10½" coil.

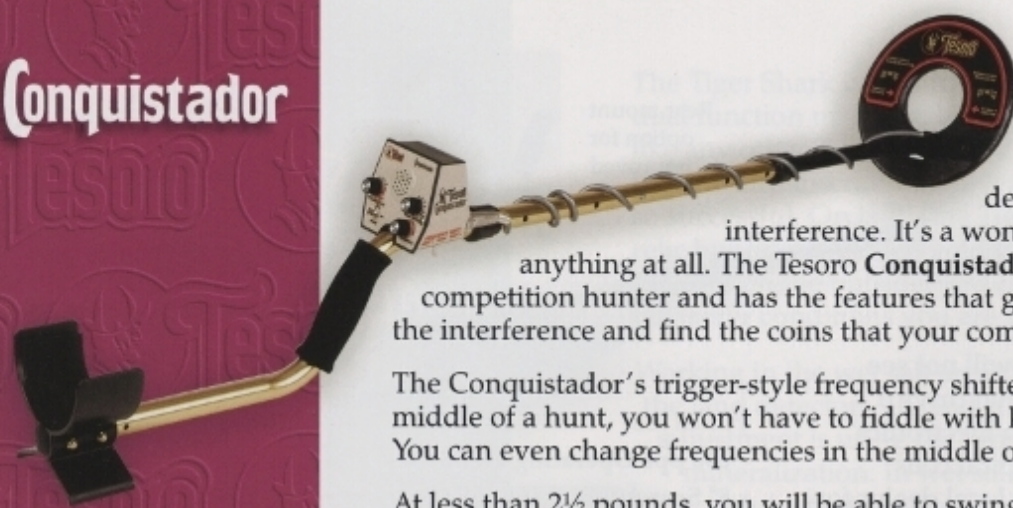

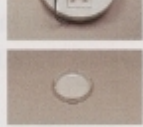

As targets pass through the bubble, they start interfering with or breaking the flux lines. The detector reads the interruption of flux lines and a signal is produced.

Don't worry about coils that create cones, blades or arrows. When you saturate the ground with electromagnetic flux lines, you're guaranteed better sensitivity to smaller targets and more depth on larger targets. Tesoro offers a simple, high-tech solution to your real world problems.
